



**HELL'S CANYON PAINT HORSE CLUB
OPEN JACKPOT PERFORMANCE FUTURITIES
FUTURITY RULES
May 15th & 16th, 2010
Walla Walla Fairgrounds, Walla Walla, Washington**

1. Futurities open to all registered horses with APHA (Solid Paint Bred/BS and Regular Registry).
2. Registration papers must be sent to the Futurity Secretary with entry, or provided at the show to Participate. No Exceptions.
3. Entry Fees: \$65 - 100% payback (\$5 office fee) plus \$25 added money, for every 3 horses that enter the ring per futurity, with a maximum of \$100 added per class.
4. **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS.**
5. All prepaid entries must be **postmarked no later than May 1st, 2010. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
LATE ENTRY FEE: \$75 LATE ENTRIES FOR THE YEARLING IN-HAND TRAIL AND LONGELINE WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE SHOW, UP UNTIL THE OFFICE CLOSES ON FRIDAY, MAY 14TH. LATE ENTRIES FOR THE ENGLISH HUS MATURITY AND WESTERN MATURITY, WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE SHOW, UP UNTIL THE OFFICE CLOSES ON SATURDAY, MAY 15TH. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE PAID IN CASH ONLY. NO CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR LATE ENTRIES.
6. No substitutions will be allowed.
7. In each and every futurity, horses will be placed from first to tenth place according to the number entering the ring. Each horse will receive points according to it's placing. The point system is as follows:

8. Paybacks will be based on the number of entries that enter the ring.
9. A tie-breaker judge will be drawn for each class. The tie-breaker judge will be used for awards only, monies will be evenly split.

10. Payouts will be distributed to the winners within 4 weeks of the show.
11. Prize money will be paid to the person who paid the entry and/or provided the SS# on the entry.
12. If a curb strap is used, it must be below the reins, and it must be of leather, braided nylon, or chain; all to be no less than ½ inch and to lie flat against the jaw.
13. No martingales, nosebands, or other training devices to be used.
14. Hackamore is to be a rawhide, leather braided, or rope bosal. No iron will be permitted under the jaw regardless of how padded or taped.
15. The 5 Year Old and Older Open Maturity Classes are Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle.
16. All Open Performance Futurity Classes will have a 5 minute warm-up. Tack will be checked prior to entering the ring. Any horse with illegal tack will be excused.
17. Yearling Longeline entries will be judged on way of going only (per NSBA) no conformation at halter. There will be a 90 second time limit per entry. No yearling entered in the Open Yearling Longeline Futurity may have head tie downs of any kind or be bitten while on the show grounds. Violations will cause disqualifications with no refunds. All entry fees will be forfeited.
18. The Yearling In-Hand Trail Futurity will be judged according to the APHA Yearling-In Hand Trail rules.
19. Owners and or exhibitors will be responsible for entering the eligible horse in the correct futurity class.
20. Any person on suspension from APHA is not eligible to exhibit in any Hell's Canyon PHC Open Futurity.
21. The Hell's Canyon PHC reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entry. Hell's Canyon PHC may also disqualify or prohibit exhibitors or entries without claims for damages.
22. The Hell's Canyon PHC will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to horses exhibited; or any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, stolen, destroyed, or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury, or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any horses or article owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Hell's Canyon against all legal or other proceedings, claims, or demands of any kind of nature in regards thereto, or that may arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse or article.
23. Any complaints must be presented to the Hell's Canyon PHC in writing. All decisions made by the committee are final. Verbal abuse and un-sportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated, and contestant may be disqualified and monies and awards forfeited. APHA will be notified by letter regarding the incident. In these cases, there will be NO refund of entries paid and contestant loses the right to claim for damages.
