## Show information & Rules

**Host Motel – Capri Motel** - There are a block of rooms reserved under “BMPHC/HCPHC”. Their phone number is 1-800-451-1139.

### Stall Reservations:

Regular Stall Fees are \$100.00 each. Discounted stall fees for early payment are \$85.00, if postmarked on or before 4-30-10! No stall refunds after 5-10-10. One bag of shavings is provided for each stall. Additional bags of shavings will be available for purchase on the grounds. Stall fees cover Thursday through Sunday (does not include Sunday night). Anyone planning to arrive prior to Thursday needs to make arrangements with Michele Daniels (stall manager) @ 541-922-3957.

Haul-In Fee: \$15 per horse per day.

**Any returned check will be assessed a \$25.00 collection fee per offense, and future payments may need to be in cash or certified funds. Any unpaid balances will be reported to APHA.**

High Point and Reserve High Point Awards to all Youth Categories, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Senior Horse, Junior Horse, Yearling In-Hand, Breeding Stock/Solid Paint Bred, and Halter. Horse must compete in at least one performance class to be eligible for high point. **Halter will count towards High Point, but is not required.**

Classes may be combined as entries warrant. All scratches and refunds will be handled according to APHA rules SC-160.D, SC-175.A, and SC-185.A. All class scratches and additions should be done in the show office at least 3 classes prior to the class being added/scratched.

### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:

Temporary APHA Membership Cards available for purchase at the show office. **ALL Exhibitors must have a current APHA Membership Card.** Please refer to APHA rules SC-160.A, AM-015.A, AM-210.A, YP-005.A, and YP-255.A.

NOTE: All horses must have registration papers (or copy of) presented at the show office. All Youth, Novice Youth, Amateurs, and Novice Amateurs must present their current youth or amateur cards at the show office. These cards may be purchased at the show office.

### ATTENTION DOG OWNERS:

Dogs must be on a leash or in a crate/carrier at all times. Dogs will be allowed in the camping areas only. No dogs will be allowed in the arena, warm-up area, in the stall barns, or in the seating/grandstand areas.

NOTE: **NO HORSES ALLOWED ON THE GRASS AREAS** of the fairgrounds at anytime, according to the fairgrounds rules!

Camping/RV reservations will not be taken in advance. The cost for an RV Camping spot will be \$15/night and will be done on a first-come, first-serve basis. You must obtain an RV Pass to post in your RV and/or Campers when you get to the show.

Warm-Up Trail Course will be open during halter events on Saturday. Cost \$10 for 10 minutes of practice time. Both courses will be open for practice during the 10 minute allotted time period so an exhibitor can practice on one or both courses as they choose. The warm-up trail course will not be an identical course to the actual trail classes for the show and may not contain all the obstacles being used in the actual trail class. This will provide an opportunity to work one's horse over various trail obstacles.

BMPHC and HCPHC, along with the Walla Walla Fairgrounds, insist on humane treatment of all animals. Cruel and unusual treatment, neglect, abuse, or misuse of horses will **NOT** be tolerated under any circumstances.
